Fresh, Quick, Healthy & Tasty
Whole Wheat Pasta/Fresh Tomato Salsa
Recipe by Chef Bianca Savary Bianco

1 # fresh tomatoes chopped	4 Tbs. olive oil
5 garlic cloves minced	Salt & Black pepper to taste
1/4 c fresh torn basil leaves	Grated parmesan to serve
1# whole wheat pasta	

1. Put a pot of salted water to boil.
2. Meanwhile, mix all prepared ingredients together. Let mixture sit for 20 minutes. Taste for salt and pepper.
3. When water comes to a boil add pasta and stir. Cook according to package directions.
4. Drain and immediately add to tomato, garlic mixture. Toss, taste for salt and pepper, add parmesan and serve.
